From 2008 the emphasis is still on helping local disabled. The lucky charity this time is Canine Partners, who will receive at least £14,000 over two years to train a Retriever puppy. The selected puppy is called 'Guy' and he will eventually assist a disabled person with some of the day to day chores the able bodied take for granted. Guy will will be trained to open washing machine doors and empty the contents, collect the mail and assist with dressing and undressing plus many other menial but important and difficult tasks required by the disabled.

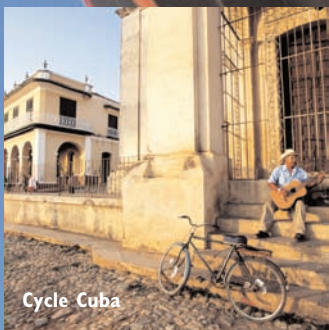

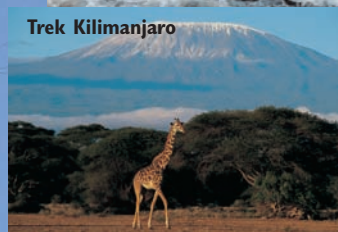

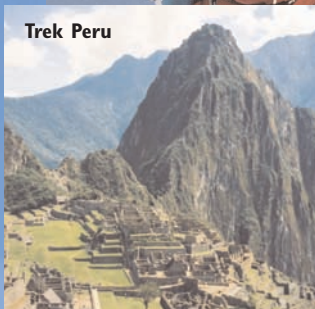
